Entry fee will be: \$250 *Miss and Teen Division(s)* and \$200 *for the Mrs. Division*. Please mail by deadline of July 12th, 2010. \$10 late fee will be applied post deadline. You can be a resident of anywhere in the State of Louisiana to be able to participate in this pageant.

If you are interested in defraying the entry fee cost, you can elect to sell ads for the program booklet. We will be selling full page & half page ads for the program. We would like to encourage you to sell ads in order to let the community know that you are competing in the pageant. Please fill out the *Program Book Advertisement Form* and mail it in for each business you sell to. The person who sells the most ads will receive an award and be featured on the back cover of the book. We will also have an early bird special. You will receive \$20.00 off of entry fees if application is received by July 2, 2010.
